

## FINDING YOUR CORRIGO SIZE

The following charts will help you to find the best Corrigo size for you. Use the measurement guides to find your hip, elbow, backrest and popliteal dimensions, find the corresponding sizes within the chart, and that will show you the correct size to order.

<b>Junior Corrigo</b>	430	350	400-480	350-430	Designed for children aged 7 – 14 years.
<b>Corrigo Custom Made/ Size 1</b>	385	355-405	490-560	440-470	Small size with a short seat depth, slim armrest width and short backrest
<b>Corrigo Size 2</b>	440	410-460	540-600	460-490	Average size, but with a slim armrest and seat width
<b>Corrigo Size 3</b>	500	470-520	540-600	460-490	Average size, with standard armrest and seat width
<b>Corrigo Size 4</b>	500	470-520	540-600	490-520	Tall size with a longer seat

### MEASUREMENT GUIDES

#### \*Measurement A (Seat Width)

Find this measurement to guide you to the right seat width. Measure the hips from the outer point to outer point.

#### \*Measurement B (Armrest Width)

Find this measurement to guide you to the right armrest width. Measure the distance between the elbows (taken with arms resting by the side of the body). **NB: It is very important that this measurement is accurate to ensure the armrest width is not too wide.**

#### \*Measurement C (Backrest Height)

Find this measurement to guide you to the right backrest height. Measure the total height between 'the base of your spine to the top of your shoulders. Do note, however, that it is more important to choose the correct seat and armrest width for the body, than the backrest height. It is important to find a close fit.

#### \*Measurement D (Seat Depth)

Find this measurement to guide you to the right seat depth. Measure the total length of your thigh, from the base of your spine to underneath your knee. **NB: This measurement should be accurate to avoid the seat depth being too deep.**

<b>Gas Lift 1 (Footrest required)</b>	Less than 440
<b>Gas Lift 1</b>	440-540 NB - Minimum height of the angular base is 500mm, suitable for users 5ft 11" and above.
<b>Gas Lift 2</b>	540-640

#### \*Measurement E: (Sitting Height)

This will give the chair height required. Measure from the floor up to behind the knees (the user should be at a sitting position with feet flat on ground, wearing everyday shoes)
